Speakers

The relationships are more varied, complex, and sophisticated than first meets the eye. So, what is that bug and what is it doing in that flower? Armed with camera and thinking cap, John Lampkin has been investigating such questions and will share some amazing insights he has documented in this beautiful, educational, and entertaining photographic presentation.

with Vince Capp. Do you sometimes find shorebirds confusing? Want to improve your skills? Vince will present an overview that will assist beginners, but also will address some of the more challenging IDs for more advanced birders.
